Speaking Topic Overview

The Apostle Peter made it clear how false believers sneak into fellowship and cause trouble. Many suffer trouble and come to fellowship seeking help and support. However, many are satanic implants as described by Christ in His parable of the Weeds.

The Apostle Peter explains how these deceitful people pretend to follow Christ yet suffer wrong for wrongdoing and how they: "Count it pleasure to revel in the daytime. They are blots and blemishes, reveling in their deceptions, while they feast with you. They have eyes full of adultery, insatiable for sin. They entice unsteady souls. They have hearts trained in greed. Accursed children! Forsaking the right way, they have gone astray. They have followed the way of Balaam, the son of Beor, who loved gain from wrongdoing" (2 Peter 2:13-15).

This two-hour message clears up the confusion and allows Christians to understand how God works spiritual among His people.

Through the years of ministry Pastor Pretlow has had to expose, confront, and often chase out hidden evil implanted within the congregation. He can expound by experience sound doctrine in exposing darkness and the spiritual warfare that arises out these conflicts.
